- ✓ Sustain the remarkable improvement recorded in indicators between October 2017 and March 2018
- ✓ Use the RMNCAH scorecard and other available evidence in decision making and health resources allocation
- ✓ Strengthen defaulter tracing mechanisms to improve the 4th ANC visits to address the visible leakages between the 1st and 4th visit. This will help reduce preventable maternal deaths
- ✓ Seek the creation of a dedicated budget line and allocate resources for family planning to support interventions that improve the FP service indicators (e.g. demand creation, training and support supervision)
- ✓ Strengthen the health data management systems to improve the quality, completeness and timeliness of health information
