

We ask

- ✓ The Lagos State Government to increase the numbers of Primary Health Centres with Health Workers trained in Adolescent and Sexual Reproductive Health by 5%.
- ✓ The Lagos State Ministry of Health to allocate and ensure timely release of funding for demand generation activities.
- ✓ The Lagos State Ministry of Health to collaborate with the Private Health Facilities by providing Family Planning commodities where feasible.
- ✓ The Lagos State Ministry of Health to advocate to the Federal Ministry of Health to ensure all Private Health facilities offering Family Planning services are on DHIS2 platform.
- ✓ The Public Health Sustainable Advocacy Initiative (PHSAI) to advocate to the Ministry of Local Government and Community Affairs for the inclusion of Family Planning in the LGA budget.
- ✓ The Lagos State Primary Health Care Board (LSPHCB) to increase the percentage of Public Health Facilities providing FP where Family Planning Supportive Supervision (FPSS) is conducted from 30% in 2021 to 40% in 2022.

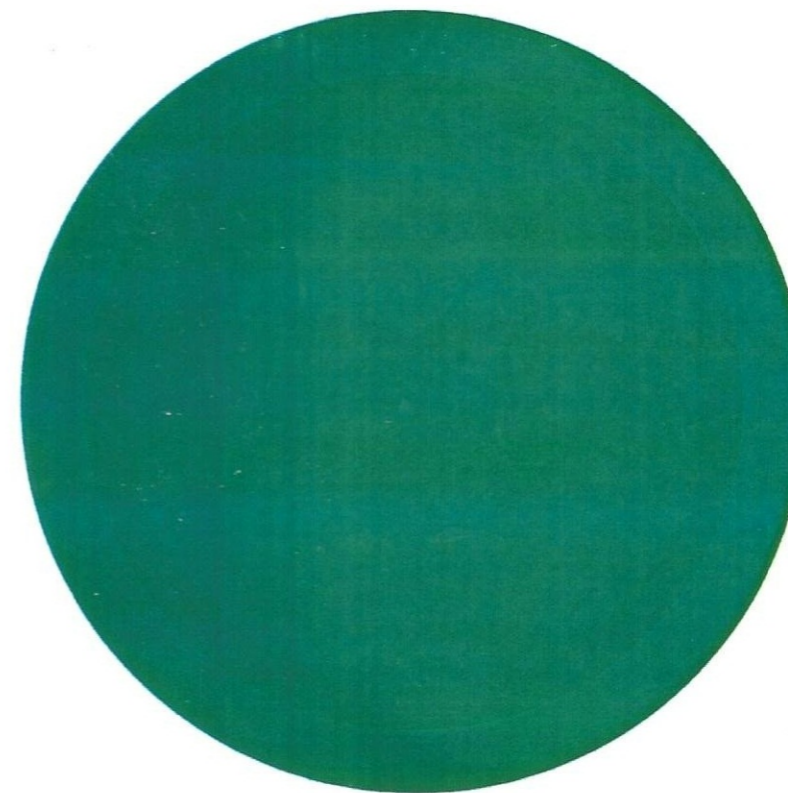
