



# Jigawa State ISS Scorecard



**Data for 12 CEmONC hospitals, and BEmONC  
health facilities in 9 Gunduma Districts**

This scorecard highlights the performance of twelve Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Neonatal (CEmONC) hospitals, and summarises data obtained from Basic Emergency Obstetric and Neonatal Care health facilities in nine Gunduma Districts in Jigawa State.

Data was collected using the Integrated Supportive Supervision (ISS) checklist and maternal newborn and child health (MNCH) indicators for the quarters preceding January 2013, April 2013 and January 2014. Data was unavailable for the quarters preceding July 2013 and October 2013.

Health facility performance is summarised across four areas: patient care; facility management procedures; finances, equipment and infrastructure; drug supply system; routine immunisation; and maternal, newborn and child health.

This booklet aims to provide key data to support evidence-based decision making and planning in Jigawa State.

## Patients Care Performance Management

**Criteria assessed:** The availability of doctors 24 hours a day, seven days a week; protocols are available and in use; clinical and management meetings are regularly held; information is available and in use; education and communication (IEC) materials are available and in use; and effective sharps and material disposal methods are in place.

**Criteria assessed:** There are up-to-date immunisation registers, and plans are available for tracking any immunisation dropout in the facility; the hospital has not experienced and vaccine stock-outs in the last 3 months; and the hospital cold chain system is adequate and functional, providing services daily.

## Maternal, Newborn and Child Health Performance

**Criteria assessed:** The hospital provides services for the integrated management of childhood illness; maternity services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week; antenatal care (ANC) and postnatal care (PNC) services are available; hospital staff are trained to promote Kangaroo Mother Care practices to clients with low birth weight babies; safe delivery cards are used; and staff have all received lifesaving skills training.

**Criteria assessed:** Facility staff all received a supervisory visit the previous month from the Gunduma Health System Council; management meetings occur regularly, and the minutes are recorded; there are transport arrangements for clinic referrals; and the facility has links with trained Traditional Birth Attendants (TBAs).

**Criteria assessed:** The facility has supplies of tracer drugs; facility store records and registers and in use and up-to-date; monthly drug fund valuation statements are prepared and submitted to the GHSC; and there are arrangements to ensure that drugs do not expire in the facility.

**Criteria assessed:** There are up-to-date immunisation registers, and plans are available for tracking any immunisation dropout in the facility; the PHC has not experienced and vaccine stock-outs in the last 3 months; and the PHC cold chain system is adequate and functional, the facility should also provide services (at least) weekly and outreach services should be available.

## Maternal, Newborn and Child Health Programme

**Criteria assessed:** The facility provides services for the integrated management of childhood illness; antenatal care (ANC) and postnatal care (PNC) services are available; facility staff are trained to promote Kangaroo Mother Care practices to clients with low birth weight babies; and the facility keeps a record of the weight of all children under five years who attend the clinic in a standard register.
